

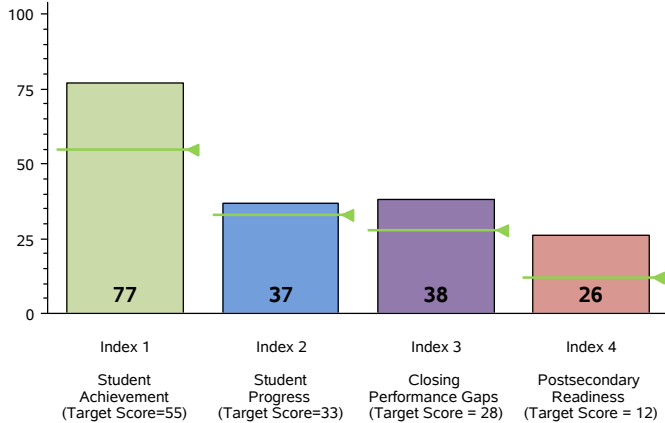

2014 Performance Index
