

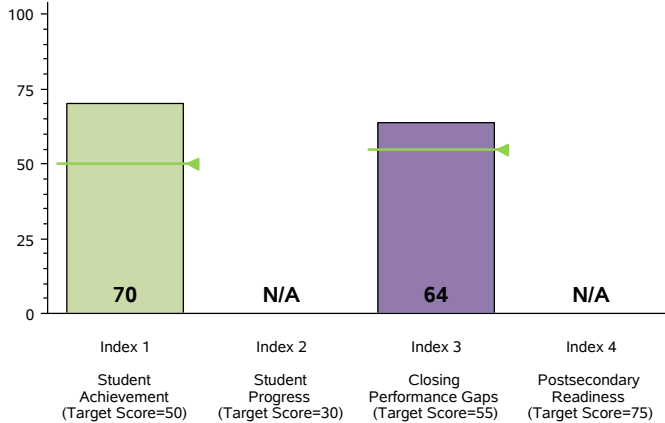

2013 Performance Index
